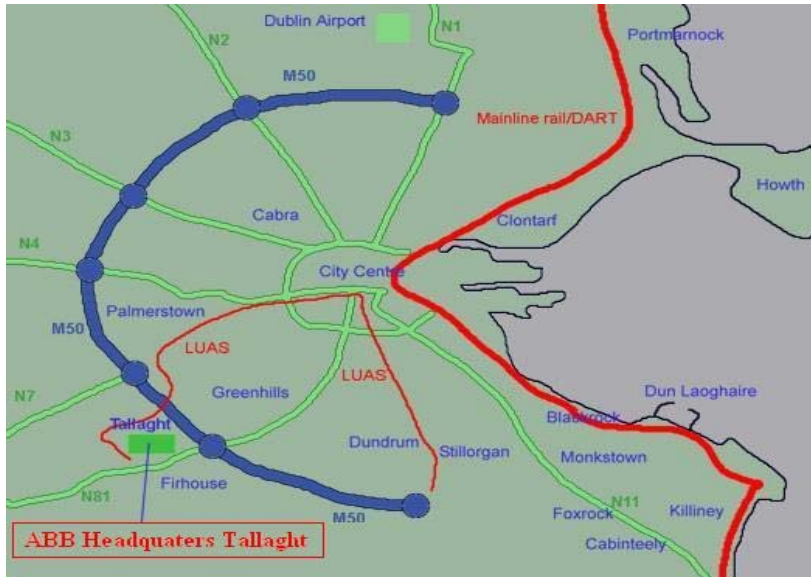


Directions to ABB Dublin Office

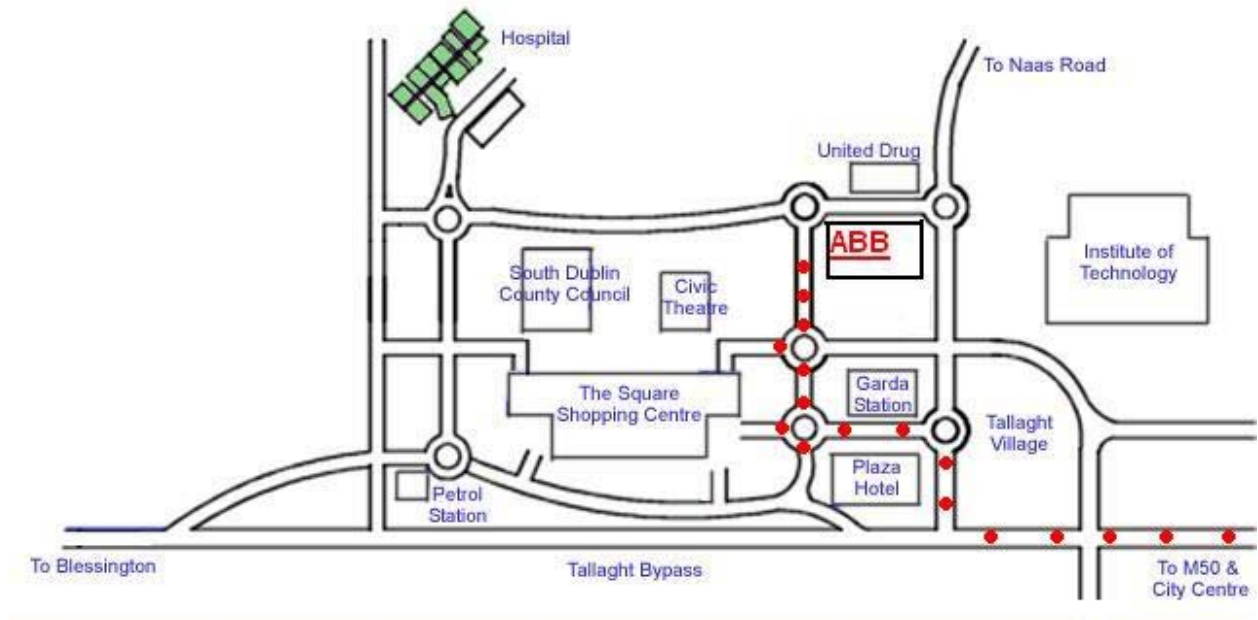
ABB is situated in South West Dublin and is easily accessible by car or bus. It is close to the M50 and N81 motorways as shown on the Dublin map below.



By Car via the M50

Travel south on the M50 and exit at the Firhouse roundabout. Follow the signs for Tallaght. You are now travelling on the N81. Continue straight on this road for approximately 1km through the roundabouts and traffic lights. The landmarks that you pass include (on right) the Plaza Hotel and the Square Shopping Centre (on left) a public park. The right hand turn for the hospital is signposted shortly after you pass these landmarks. The hospital is clearly marked from here. It is second turn on your right. You will then see the hospital entrance on your left.

The map below shows the area around ABB and how to enter from the M50.



By Bus

The following buses will drop you at the gates of the hospital, highlighted in green in the map above - **49, 49A, 50, 54A, 65, 65B, 65C, 77, 77A**. All these buses leave from Eden Quay in the City Centre near O'Connell Street.

The following buses are also available:

- The **75** runs from Dun Laoghaire
- The **76** runs from Ballyfermot
- The **76A** runs from Blancherstown
- The **201** and **202** are local Tallaght buses.

For details of pick up points along any of these routes contact the Dublin Bus Ringsend Depot (01 703 4533) or alternatively you can contact Dublin Bus Passenger Information Service on (01) 873 4222 or look up www.dublinbus.ie.

All these buses stop at the Square Shopping Centre in Tallaght. This is a very short walk from ABB, maximum 5minutes.

By Train

You can now take the Luas to ABB. The Luas is now accessible outside Heuston and Connolly Station and has a stops outside the shopping centre. See information below on the Luas.

By Taxi

A taxi from Dublin Airport to ABB will cost approximately €45, this will fluctuate depending on traffic volumes on the M50. This amount is not exact and is only given as an indication of the approximate cost for someone who is considering this option.

By Luas

ABB is now accessible by the red line on the Luas. The line starts at Connelly Station, runs through Middle Abbey Street, Heuston Station and finishes in Tallaght. Trams run daily and the average cost of an adult is 2euro for a one-way ticket.

Times of the Red Line

Monday-Friday: 0530-0030

On average, trams depart every 20 minutes. During peak times, trams run every 7.5-10 minutes.

Saturday: 0630-0030

The first tram leaves Connelly station at 0700

Sunday and Public Holidays: 0700-23-30
