History:

- 1883 Elektriska Aktiebolaget, a predecessor of Asea, is established in Sweden.
- 1891 Brown, Boveri and Cie (BBC) is established in Switzerland.
- 1907 The Knut Gadelius Company of Sweden opens its first Japanese branch in Yokohama (later ABB Gadelius K.K.) to import and distribute high-quality Swedish industrial products.
- 1944 Fuso Donetsu Kogyo K.K. is established.
- 1963 Ransburg Japan K.K. (later Ransburg Automotive K.K.) is established.
- 1974 Asea and Gadelius jointly establish Asea Gadelius K.K. (later ABB Industry K.K.).
- 1988 Asea and BBC merge to form ABB (Asea Brown Boveri).
- 1991 Ransburg Automotive K.K. and Fuso Donetsu Kogyo K.K. join ABB, and are renamed ABB Ransburg K.K. and ABB Fuso K.K.
- 1993 Shimada Technical Center opened.
- 1995 ABB Gadelius K.K. is renamed ABB K.K.
- 1996 ABB Industry K.K., ABB Ransburg K.K. and ABB Fuso K.K. are merged into ABB Industry K.K.
- 1998 Turbo Systems United Co., Ltd. is established jointly by Ishikawajima-Harima Heavy Industries Co., Ltd. (IHI) and ABB K.K.
- 1999 ABB K.K. and ABB Industry K.K. merge; Bailey Japan Co., Ltd., (today ABB Bailey Japan) a joint venture of IHI and Kyokuto Boeki Kaisha, Ltd., joins ABB K.K.
- 2001 ABB K.K.'s Tokyo Headquarters are relocated to Shibuya.
- 2004 ABB K.K. and Meidensha jointly establish MSA Co., Ltd.
- 2008 Mishima Service Center opened.
- 2009 Kansai Branch opened.
